SAFETY DIRECTIONS

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND THE ENVIRONMENT

Ivermectin is extremely toxic to aquatic species. Do not contaminate dams, rivers, streams or other

waterways with the chemical or used container.

DISPOSAL

Triple rinse containers before disposal. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on-site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulation. Do not burn empty containers or product.

STORAGE

Store below 30°C (Room Temperature) in the closed, original container. Store bottle in carton to protect from light.

Additional information required under the Globally Harmonised System (GHS) classification of the substance/mixture:
